


Submitting VeriCite Assignments to Canvas


VeriCite is an anti-plagiarism tool that is now fully integrated with Canvas. When an instructor makes an assignment where VeriCite is used, you will be able to check the Originality Report when it is completed by VeriCite.

1. Submit your assignment to Canvas by clicking on the **Submit Assignment** button.





3. Submit the Assignment.






- Once the report is ready, you can click on the button showing the **Originality** score to see your **VeriCite** results.

Calendar FAQ's

Can I link my Google Calendar to the Calendar in Canvas?

Because we use Office 365, Google tools don't integrate with Canvas. Thus a Google Calendar can't be integrated with the Calendar in Canvas. You can however link to a Google Calendar by copying the URL of the Google Calendar and adding it to any tool in the Rich Text Editor.

How do I add important dates to the Calendar?

When creating assignments, the due dates are automatically added to the Calendar. Those assignments and dates are also added automatically to the Syllabus tool.
